Use Of School Space During The School Day
KRS 160.345(2)(i)5

Type:	Required

By the end of each school year, the principal shall assign the use of space in the school based on criteria, which considers the following:

1. Safety of students and staff;
2. Implementation of the school improvement plan;
3. Accessibility for persons with a disability;
4. Curriculum and program needs;
5. Differentiation of instruction;
6. Demands of technology;
7. Supervision of students, and;
8. Effective school management.

The principal shall assign non-classroom space based on the criteria listed above after consulting with staff members who work or will work in any space affected by change.

After assigning school space, the principal may alter those assignments based on the following:

1. When necessary to respond to unanticipated enrollment or staffing changes;
2. When the principal and affected staff agree a change is needed, or
3. When the council changes other policies or the school improvement plan and the minutes reflect that those changes may require assignments, which cannot be delayed until future school years.
