Participation in and Availability of Extracurricular Activities

“Extracurricular activities” is defined as organized sports or teams representing the school. The principal shall present to the Council any new program(s) to be implemented by the school for approval. The Council shall approve any additional programs before they are implemented. The principal shall review all programs.

The Council shall strive to make extracurricular activities available to all students. However, participation is considered a privilege. Students must be enrolled in the Greenup County School District in order to participate in any extracurricular activities. They must also maintain satisfactory grades and be in good standing with the school by demonstrating good attendance and behavior. A student must be present in school the day of any activity in order to participate in an after school game, practice, or other event.

A student who is in good academic standing meets the following requirements:

- Maintains a “C” average in all classes throughout a term.
- Does not have a failing grade in 2 or more classes throughout a term.

A student who does not meet the academic requirements may not attend practice or participate in any way in the extracurricular activity until the requirements are met. If the academic requirements have not been met within two weeks, the student will be dismissed from the team.

Proper school attendance is required to be a member of any extracurricular program. If a student exceeds 5 unexcused absences, he/she will not be permitted to participate in the activity. If the number is exceeded during the activity’s season, the student will be dismissed from the team. Any other attendance issues will be monitored and addressed by the principal.

Any extracurricular activity specific rule or expectation will be supported by the Council. At any time, the principal can deem a student ineligible for any length of time due to disciplinary reasons.

All district and state policies and procedures will be adhered to involving extracurricular activities.
