Monitoring Student Achievement Policy

The principal shall annually review assessment data received from the Kentucky Department of Education with the council. Student achievement scores, college ready benchmark scores, non-duplicated gap students' scores, and growth percentiles will be examined by the school council. The principal, along with the council, will determine specific areas of need and take steps to align instructional practices to meet these needs.

After the review of state assessment data, goals for the Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP) will be established. Activities and strategies that target these goals will also be established.

At the discretion of the council, some of this work may be referred to a committee including parents, faculty, and staff who would then make recommendations to the council for their approval and action. The principal shall make the CSIP available for review to all stakeholders prior to council approval.

Planning for Improvement

The council shall approve a Comprehensive School Improvement Plan which shall be developed each year. The plan shall be based on a review of school data which can include test data, surveys, discipline statistics, attendance data, and any other pertinent information that is vital to improved student achievement.

Any local assessment data will be reviewed and monitored by the principal and council throughout the school year.
